Concept

Conflict

Define the central challenge tied to your main idea. Conflict creates tension and momentum, giving your characters something to overcome and your readers something to root for.

Characters

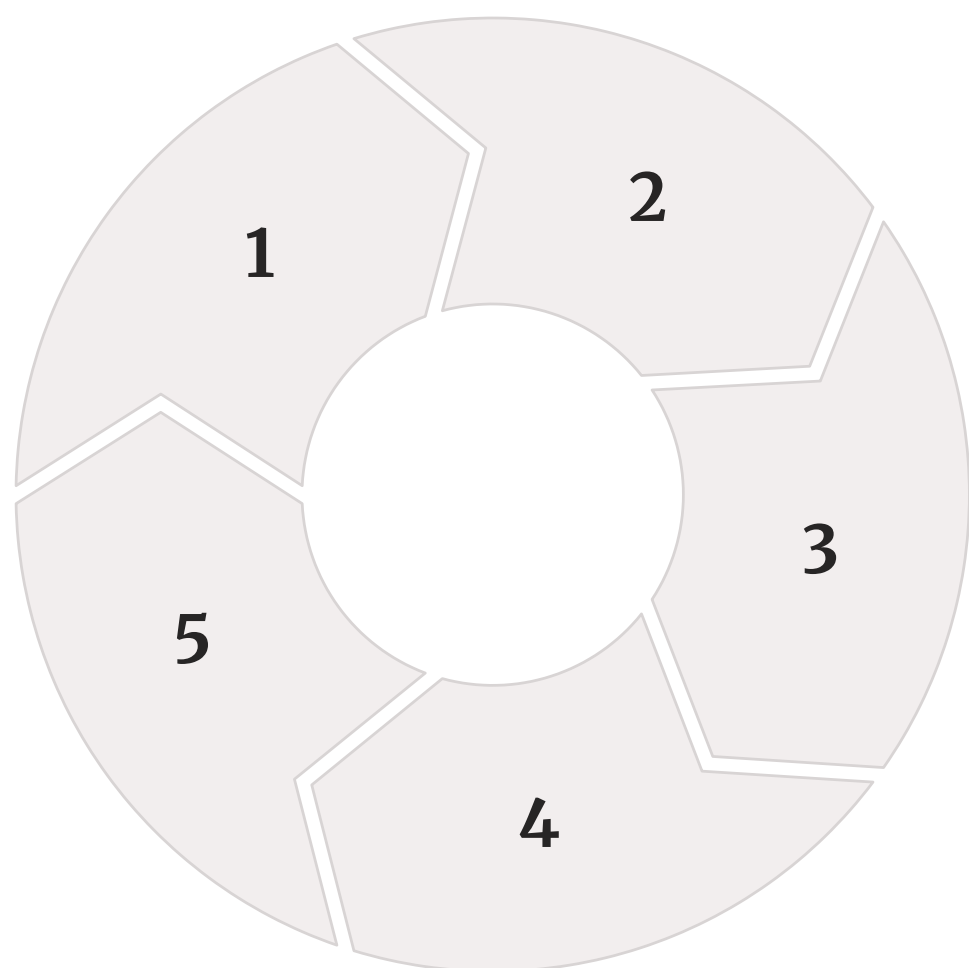
Create relatable heroes with unique traits, fears, and dreams. Strong characters serve as vehicles for exploring human nature and different responses to life's challenges.

Context

Build an engaging world through a guided questionnaire that helps you establish setting, time period, cultural elements, and the rules that govern your story's universe.

Mapping Your Plot

After establishing your fundamental elements, the T-Diary guides you through plot development using the Hero's Journey. This archetypal pattern appears across cultures and throughout history, providing a powerful framework for your story.



1 The Ordinary World

Establish your hero's starting point and normal life before adventure begins.

2 The Call to Adventure

Introduce the challenge or opportunity that disrupts the status quo.

3 Trials and Tribulations

Create obstacles that test your hero's resolve and abilities.

4 Transformation

Show how your hero changes through facing their greatest fears.

5 The Return

Bring your hero back, changed and bearing gifts of wisdom.





Bringing Your Story to Life

In the final stage of the T-Diary process, you'll transform your outline into a fully realized draft by completing your story scene by scene with vivid details, meaningful dialogue, and even visual elements if you choose.

1

Sensory Details

Add descriptions that engage all five senses, making your world tangible to readers. The T-Diary includes prompts to help you create immersive environments.

2

Authentic Dialogue

Craft conversations that reveal character personalities and advance your plot simultaneously. Practice exercises help you find each character's unique voice.

3

Emotional Landscape

Explore the feelings that drive your characters' actions and decisions, creating deeper connections with readers who recognize these universal experiences.

4

Visual Storytelling

Use the dedicated sketching spaces to draw scenes, character portraits, maps, or symbolic elements that enhance your written narrative.
